This year's Neurobiology of Disease Workshop (NDW) takes place on October 13th in Atlanta, Georgia. Sponsored by the Society for Neuroscience and funded by NINDS and the Motor Neuron Center, the program will focus on motor neuron diseases such as ALS and MSA.
